

Donating ponytails through Sustainable Salons

Your hair can be transformed into a wig for someone experiencing hair loss due to a medical condition like cancer.

Important Note: Donations under 20cm can't be made into wigs but can still make a difference!

Synthetic hair extensions (only 100% human hair extensions accepted), dreadlocks, wet or loose hair.



1 Wash and dry hair

Dry thoroughly and do not apply any styling product (e.g. wax, hairspray, serums, etc.). It doesn't matter if your hair is dyed, it's still eligible for donation.

2 Section hair into small ponytails

Secure each ponytail with an elastic band 1-2cm above where you intend to cut, braid tightly, and secure with another elastic at the end. **Ensure the elastic is tight**—if the ponytail comes loose, it won't be viable for donation.



3 Cut each ponytail

In order to be eligible for wig-making, ponytails should be at least **20cm long** and **cut 1-2 cm above the elastic band**.

4 Bag the ponytails and donation form

Fill in the **Ponytail Donation Form**, then place it together with the ponytails in an envelope or plastic snaplock bag and seal tightly.




5 Send to Sustainable Salons
